Hope College is a Christian senior high school. It has been registered with the Registrar General's Department of Ghana as well as with the Ghana Education Service. It is an approved West African Examinations Council centre for the May/June West African Senior School Certificate Examination.

Hope College's distinctiveness is in the fact that the four pillars upon which it is established - character, scholarship, service and leadership - are virtues that are inculcated in each student to become a part of his or her life.

At Hope College, we believe that character formation comes first. Christ-like character serves as a solid foundation upon which to build other virtues. 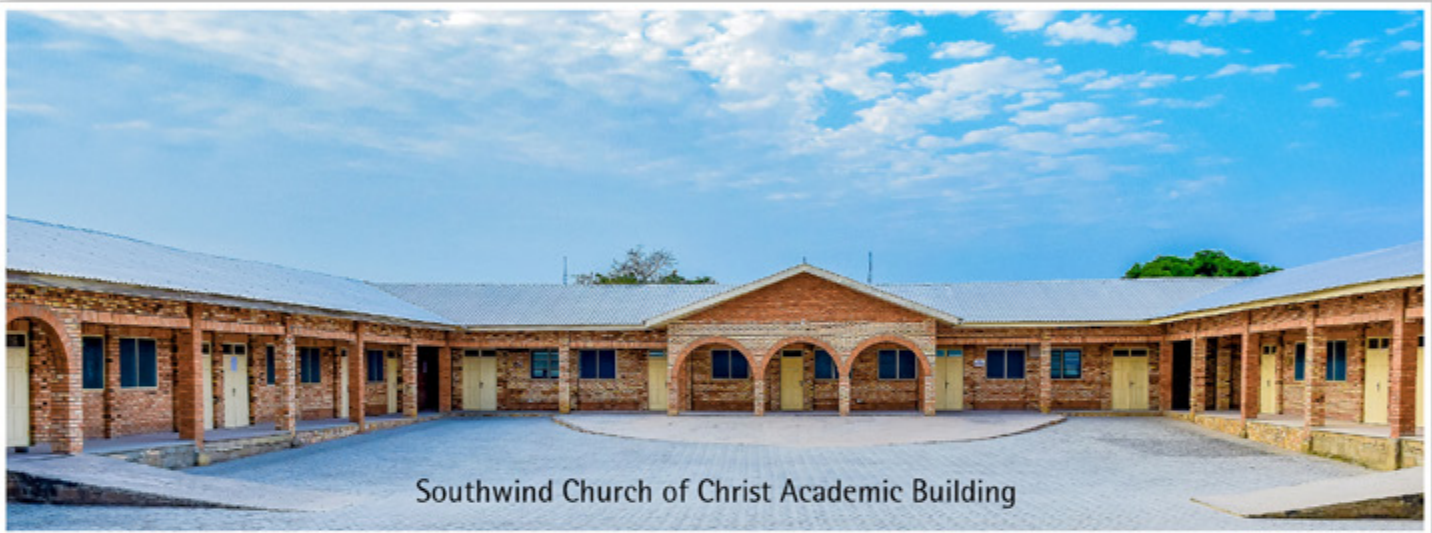
Infrastructure is carefully crafted to imitate nature and create a conducive environment for the academic, physical and spiritual development of students.

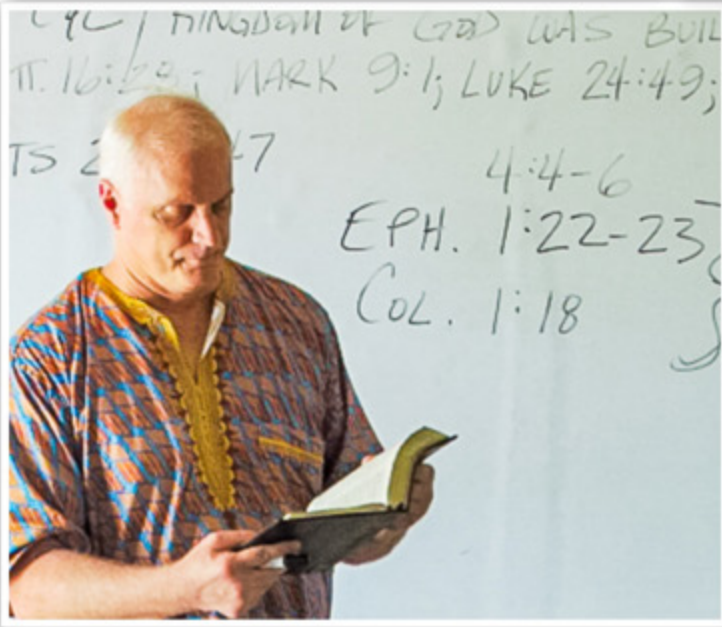
Communication is beautiful when it is done to the understanding of all people.

Physical activities are an integral part of the Hope College experience. We explore our environment to the advantage of each student.

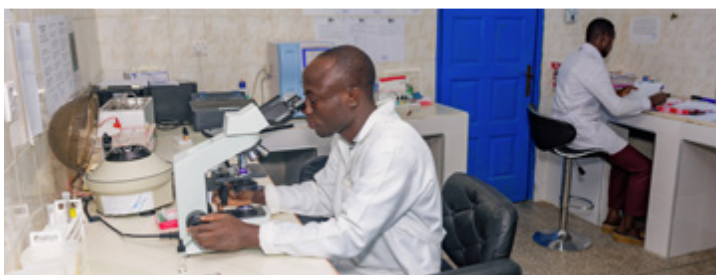
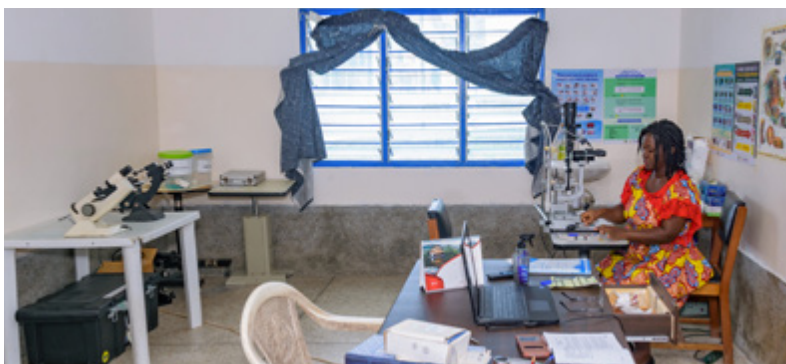

No other SHS in Ghana has this *advantage!*



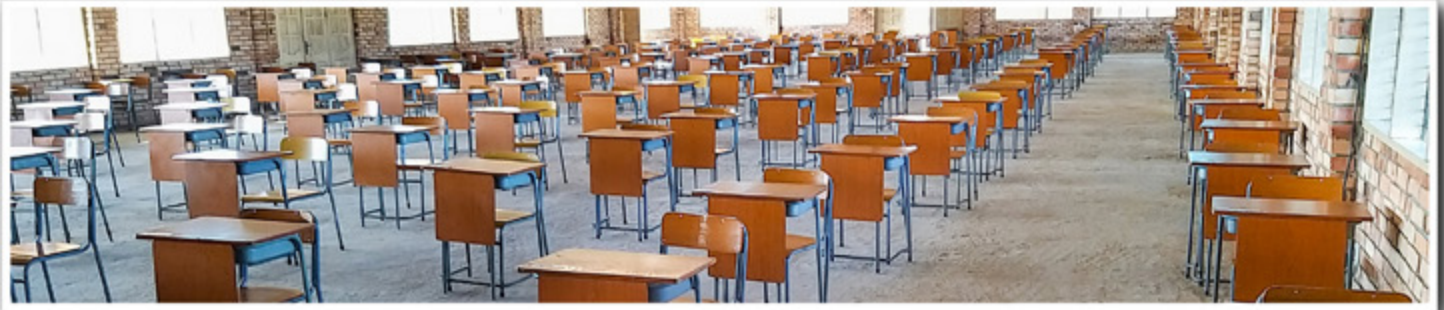
